

Certified Referee Bonus opportunity for 2012

Impact United Recreation Referees,

We are excited to offer you an incentive to become, or remain, a USSF Certified Referee. Becoming a certified referee helps you become more proficient in your job and raises the standard of refereeing in our games. In addition, certified referees are paid at a higher rate than non-certified referees - \$4.50 more per game for Grade 9, \$6.50 more per game for Grade 8. **For 2012 we are offering an End Of Year Bonus! Impact United will reimburse your Certification/Re-certification fees when you referee 32 Impact United Recreation games in the year (Spring 2012 and Fall 2012 combined).**

Specifics

1. Certify or Re-certify as either a Grade 9 or Grade 8 Referee for 2012.
2. Provide a photocopy of your USSF 2012 Referee Card (the one that is mailed to you with your Ref ID Number) to your Referee Coordinator.
3. Referee at least 32 games over the year - Spring and Fall seasons combined.
4. Receive a bonus of \$45 (Grade 9) or \$50 (Grade 8) with your Fall 2012 Referee check.

Benefits of being a Certified Referee with Impact United Recreation

- Earn more money doing Recreation games than Competition games¹.
- Recreation Referee shirt and whistle provided - no need to purchase Ref Uniform.
- Increased knowledge of the game of soccer will increase your playing skills.

Expectations

We pay Certified Referees more and we expect more.

- It is essential to have our Certified Referees be a clear step above in ability and professionalism.
- We need Certified Referees to mentor our non-certified referees.
- Certified Referees will be expected to accept assignments matching their level of training.
- In addition, Certified referees will be required to attend the Recreation Referee Clinic yearly to understand the Modified Rules of the Game used in Impact United Recreation and receive instruction from your Referee Coordinator.

Competition pays \$16 a game but games are scheduled 2 hours apart. Recreation games are scheduled either one hour, 1:15, or 1:30 apart allowing you to earn more per hour.

For example:

Game	Grade 9 pay	Two hour period, earn	Four hour period, earn
Recreation U8/U9/U10	\$12.50	\$25.00 (2 games)	\$50 (4 games)
Competition U11-U14	\$16.00	\$16.00 (1 game)	\$32 (2 games)

Grade 9 Referee

The Grade 9 clinic consists of a one-day **eight-hour class**, or two 4 hours classes or Three 3 hour classes designed mainly to train and certify kids and adults interested only in running lines on competition games or refereeing recreation games within specific age limits and guidelines. It also serves as an added opportunity for those who are too young to certify as Grade 8 referees.

There will be a **50 question test** on the last day of the clinic. Upon passing the test with a score of 75% or better, the participant will have the option to register with the United States Soccer Federation by filling out the registration form and paying the registration fee. The fees to register as a USSF Grade 9 referee are **\$45 a year**.

Grade 8 Referee

The Grade 8 Entry Level clinic may consists of six (6) 3-hour sessions or two (2) 8 hour sessions or some combination or classes, for a **total of sixteen to eighteen (16-18) hours of instruction**. Attendance at all sessions is required for successful completion of the course. USSF requires those wishing to certify as a Grade 8 referees, to be at least 13 years of age. Those younger than thirteen (13) will need to take the Grade 9 course.

Prior to attending this clinic, you **MUST** complete the [Grade 8 Online Training Modules at US Soccer](#). When you first start any online module, you will be requested to register. In the line requesting "Clinic Number", enter the location you are planning on attending (i.e. "Sandy") for the class room portion of the course.

There will be a **100 question test** on the last day of the clinic. Upon passing the test with a score of 75% or better, the participant will have the option to register with the United States Soccer Federation by filling out the registration form and paying the registration fee. The fee to register as a USSF grade 8 referee is **\$50 per year**.

Annual Re-Certification of Grade 8 or Grade 9 Referee

Re-certification clinics are mostly the annual in-service requirement for maintaining your certification which includes: Points of Emphasis from USSF, Knowledge of the Game, Rules of Competition and Professionalism. **Specific exam preparation is not included.**

TO PASS THE EXAM it is expected that you already know the Laws and have studied previously on your own. It is strongly encouraged that you study the following publications -

"Laws of the Game", "Advice to Referees on the Laws of the Game" and "Guide to Procedures".

Grade 8 exam is a 100 question test. The fee to re-register as a USSF grade 8 referee is **\$50**.
